



8. BOOTH ALLOCATION

The Organizer alone will allocate the stand location and surface area, subject to payment by the Exhibitor of the first deposit invoice. The Organizer will endeavor to draw up an exhibition plan considering the Exhibitor's wishes as to the size and location of the stand. The Exhibitor's wishes regarding the location are not binding on the Organizer. The Organizer reserves the right to move an allocated stand space, to change the dimensions or configuration of the stands within acceptable limits and insofar as this is compatible with the layout concept and the overall presentation of the exhibition. The implementation of such a prerogative will not give rise to any compensation whatsoever in favor of the Exhibitor.

8.1 Aménagement du stand

EPHJ Trade show is a modular hall where stands are mounted and supplied. The Exhibitor cannot bring/set up its own stand. It can freely arrange the inside of the stand that is provided by the organisation, while respecting the following rules:

- Walls: any wall, curtain, fixed decoration, etc. installed by the Exhibitor will have to be 25 cm from the limits of the stand overlooking the corridors. At the edge of the stand, overlooking the corridors, only the walls provided by the Organiser can be installed, which must remain free from any decoration or display. In order not to obstruct the view of other exhibitors, the stand must not have a wall area (provided by the Organiser) of more than 3 continuous linear metres. Should the wall space be larger, it is mandatory that the Exhibitor integrate either a display (set back 25 cm) or a showcase to cover the closed side of the wall. In order to ensure visibility for all, an Exhibitor wishing to place more than 3 metres of Organiser-supplied walls along a corridor is likely to be placed on a wall of the Exhibition at the discretion of the Organiser;
- The **limits of the stand** must not be exceeded in any case with any element whatsoever (display, flag, tablet, roll-up, furniture, machine or machine element, mobile device, robot, etc.), this as well in aisles above the stand;
- The **open sides** of a type A stand (1 open side for A1 type and 2 open sides for A2 type), must remain open. It is however allowed to close them partially with a wall provided by the Organiser, but on a third of the maximum length;
- Showcases at the edge of the corridor: only the low showcases can be placed at the edge of the corridor. The company logo may appear but no photo, text or other description. If this is the case, they will have to be set back 25 cm from the corridor:
- **TV screens**: the screens showing images should be set back 25 cm from the corridor.
- Images and representation of finished products: it is not possible to use representations of finished watchmaking or jewellery products for the purposes of decoration or animation (photos, drawings, videos etc.).

10. TECHNICAL SERVICES

Two different shops are available on the exhibitor portal: the Palexpo shop for technical services and the Eigenmann shop for fittings

- Plants and flowers

SHOP EIGENMANN

- Submission of the stand design plan for approval
- Complementary equipment for the stand
- Furniture
- Lighting fixtures
- Hanging points
- Digital printing on wall or on veil
- Etc.

PARKING CARDS

- Included in the price: 1 card (1 to 3 booths), 2 cards (2 to 6 booths), 3 cards (7 booths and more)
- Additional parking cards can be ordered from the Palexpo Shop via the exhibitor portal
- All parking passes must be collected from the exhibitor contact during set-up.

11. CATERING

Organize your cocktails on your booth by placing your orders on the exhibitor portal, in the catering tab.

12. EXHIBITOR BADGES

The creation of exhibitor badges is done on the exhibitor portal. The number of badges available depends on the surface ordered:

All invoices for the booth must be paid to print or send the badges to the employees concerned. Each badge must correspond to a unique email address. However, you can already enter the badges in advance. The badges are also available on the mobile application.

The badges are not sent automatically following the payment of the balance of the area, this sending must be done manually by you from the portal.

MAKING AN APPOINTMENT

When entering the badges, and only if you accept it, you can be contacted by visitors to make an appointment with your employees during the Show. These requests can be accepted or refused.

Visitors will be able to make their request only when the names of the employees present at the Show have been entered.

13. E-INVITATIONS AND BADGE READER

On the same platform as badge creation, you can send e-invitations in French and English to your customers and prospects. These e-invitations can be customized, and you can consult the statistics of your mailings at any time (openings, registrations, etc.) and send reminders. YOUR LIST OF EMAIL ADDRESSES REMAINS STRICTLY CONFIDENTIAL AND WE CANNOT CONSULT IT IN ANY CASE.

To scan the QR codes of the visitors, you can rent badge readers or buy the license for your smartphone.
